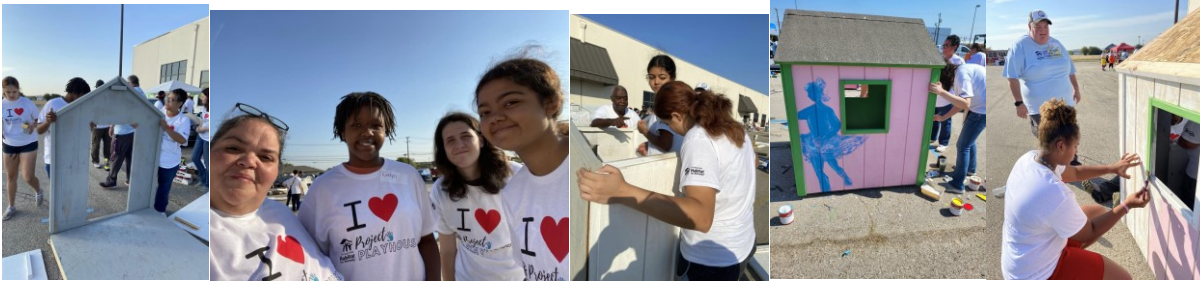

Communications: A letter of thanks from the Texas Lion Museum and Office Foundation.

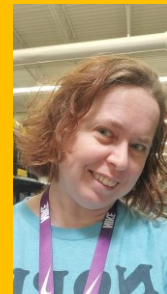
